MARHC Membership

Membership is open to anyone who has an interest in the Rural Health Clinics of Missouri. Annual MARHC membership is calculated using two factors: A base membership fee of \$250 plus a fee of \$65 for each full-time clinician over two. The base membership rate includes two clinicians or providers. For the purpose of membership, MARHC regards a clinician or provider as a: Physician, Physician Assistant, Nurse Practitioner, Certified Nurse Midwife or Licensed Clinical Social Worker. If you are a large organization that has more than 50 full-time RHC clinicians cumulatively, then you only pay the flat fee of \$3,500.
